1. All exhibits must be in place not later than 10am Saturday.
2. Competition is open to all amateur growers.
3. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor. The only exceptions are wild flowers, weeds, wild grass and corn class 157
4. Each exhibitor must furnish a container and have them arranged for exhibit.
5. Exhibitors are required to name all varieties entered.
6. Not responsible for loss or breakage of any plant or article.
7. Judging will be between 10am and noon Saturday
8. Exhibits can be removed during the Sunday parade and no later than 5pm
9. Youth age 6 – 14 years old
