King Corn Competition

1. Anyone can enter but only 1 entry per person
2. Registration will be the day of the event at the tent on the court house lawn
3. Corn husk must be pulled back.
4. The GFWC-IL Coal City Junior Woman's Club will have the final say on acceptability of entries.
5. By entering you agree to have your photo taken for promotional material, including Facebook page of Coal City Junior Woman's and the Grundy County Corn Festival.
6. Judging will start immediately after the Cornbread contest, approximately 6:00 and will award on 2 categories:
 - a. Circumference of the corn and
 - b. Length of the corn
 - Judge's will use a standard tape measure and string (for circumference). The Judge's decision is final.
 - In case of a tie, the judges will re-measure top entries. Winners will be announced approximately 6:00 pm.

Cornbread Competition

1. Limit entries to 15
2. Anyone can enter but only 1 entry per person
3. Registration forms must be submitted by September 19, 2018, at the corn festival office (909 Liberty St). You will be given an index card (name, address, email, phone #) with registration that you will attach to the bottom of Cornbread pan for blind judging.
4. Cornbread must be made from scratch
5. Bring Cornbread in a 10-12" pan to the tent on the court house lawn by 5:00 on Wednesday, September 26, 2018. You must have the index card completed and attached to the bottom of your pan.
6. No cornbread that requires refrigeration will be allowed. The GFWC-IL Coal City Junior Woman's Club will have the final say on acceptability of entries.
7. You do not get your cornbread back. By entering you agree to have your photo taken for promotional material, including Facebook page of Coal City Junior Woman's and the Grundy County Corn Festival.
8. Judging will start immediately at 5:30 and will judge on 2 categories:
 - a. Traditional cornbread with no additives such as vegetables or meat.
 - b. Non-traditional cornbread with additives such as vegetables and meat - no refrigerated cornbread will be allowed.
 - c. Judged on taste, appearance, and texture. Judge's decision is final.
 - d. Scoring will assign a number value 1-10 to each criteria without consulting the other judges. The cornbread receiving the highest total is the winner. In case of a tie, the judges will judge the top entries again. Winners will be announced approximately 6:00 pm.

After judging, the cornbread will be sliced and offered to the public for sale. All sales to go to discretion of the Corn Festival Committee.
